The DLF features a wealth of illustrative examples derived from fieldwork and textual sources and identification of the parish where the entry was collected or the source from which it was compiled. In 2008 this book, Llunari (Lunarium) was the winner of the Prize Jocs Florals de Barcelona and Josep Lluís Aguiló was appointed Poet Laureate of the City of Barcelona during the period 2008-2009. It takes up once more the theme of the uncertainty of life, and in omens and elements of fantasy, the poet reveals allegories of our everyday universe. In the long shadow of dictatorship, young Spanish rebels fight for a truly free society. The Franco dictatorship in Spain was

famously beset by armed revolutionary groups, inheritors of the legacy of Spanish anarchism that Franco had crushed. Less well-known are the Grupos Autónomos (Autonomous Groups) active during Spain's transition to "democracy," a transition set in motion and overseen by the powerful elites of the Franco regime and intended to maintain existing social and economic relations. As the country reorganized under a veneer of a parliamentary monarchy, resistance spread in the form of small autonomous bands of armed rebels who sought a more free and egalitarian future for Spain. *Agitated* is the tale of those groups. It brings alive the young people who comprised them, detailing their struggle against the faux democracy of authoritarian capitalism and the vibrant lives they lived: the counterculture they formed, their relations with workers, life underground, of course, the repression they suffered. *La losa que sella el sepulcro de Francisco Franco en el Valle de los Caídos*, sella también la memoria y el futuro de España. En él, Teresa M. Vilarós señala cuáles fueron las adicciones de la sociedad española que producen este «mono» que cimentó el consenso social sobre el que se construyó el régimen del 78. *Fables of Development: Capitalism and Social Imaginaries in Spain (1950-1967)* focuses on a basic paradox: why is it that the so-called "Spanish economic miracle" —a purportedly secular, rational, and technocratic process— was fictionally portrayed through providential narratives in which supernatural and extraordinary elements were often involved? In order to answer this question, this book examines cultural fictions and social life at the time when Spain turned from autarchy to the project of industrial and tourist development. Beyond the narratives about progress, modernity, and consumer satisfaction on a global and national level, the cultural archives of the period offer intellectual findings about the expectations of a social majority who lived in the precariousness and who did not have sufficient income to acquire the consumer goods that were advertised. Through the scrutiny of interdisciplinary archives (literary texts,

cinema, newsreels, comics, and journalistic sources, among other cultural artifacts), each chapter offers an analysis of the social imaginaries about the circulation and distribution of capital and resources in the period from 1950, when General Franco's government began to integrate into international markets and institutions following its agreements with the United States, to 1967, when the implementation of the First Development Plan (1964-1967) was completed. Silvia Roig explores the narrative of Aurora Bertrana (1892-1974), an unknown writer today, but a successful and recognized female author in Catalonia and Spain during the 20th century. Aurora Bertrana's works are almost never mentioned in manuals of literature. Her rich, intellectual work has not received the attention it deserves, relegated almost to absolute oblivion. The author reviews and studies twenty-four of Bertrana's novels written in Catalan and Spanish, including: *Ariatea* (1960), *El pomell de les violes* (MS), *L'inefable Philip* (MS), *La aldea sin hombres* (mn.), *La madrecita de los cerdos* (MS), *Entre dos silencis* (1958), *La ninfa d'argila* (1959), *Fracàs* (1966) and *La ciutat dels joves: reportatge fantasia* (1971). She studies her work, published and unpublished, from a feminist approach, taking into account the intellectual history of Spain and Catalonia. Bertrana's strong commitment to social issues reveals her association with the Modernist and Noucentists trends of her time. Bertrana's novels reveal a unique interest in non-Western cultures and lifestyles and her work undertakes controversial topics and socio-cultural issues, while she observes and draws special attention to the situation of women in different circumstances and cultural geographies. This book is therefore anchored on interpretive and theoretical parameters that intersect with consideration of gender, such as travel-and-gender and war-and-gender. Roig uses the work of feminists such as Simone De Beauvoir, Shulamith Firestone, Jelke Boesten, Margaret and Patrice Higonnet, Michelle Zimbalist Rosaldo and Julia Kristeva to help assess Bertrana's engagement with gender and socio-political issues. This approach is particularly well suited for a writer like Bertrana, a Catalan and Republican intellectual woman forced into self-exile during the Spanish Civil War and the dictatorship of Francisco Franco. Una obra, sin duda, de obligada referencia para quien, a partir de ahora, quiera adentrarse o profundizar en el Derecho civil catalán. Completadas por el Parlamento de Cataluña las primeras fases del ejercicio de la competencia exclusiva para conservar, modificar y desarrollar su Derecho civil, la promulgación de la Ley 29/2002, de 30 de diciembre, Primera ley del Código Civil de Cataluña inició un proceso legislativo que, teniendo por objetivo la consecución de un texto sistemático y con vocación omnicomprendensiva, superara las insuficiencias propias de las técnicas hasta entonces empleadas, constituidas, en una primera fase, por la adopción de la Compilación (1984), en una segunda, por la actualización mediante leyes especiales de un Derecho en buena parte anacrónico y, en una tercera, por la codificación

sectorial del Derecho de sucesiones (1991) y del Derecho de familia (1998). A pesar de que la obra legislativa civil catalana, en su conjunto, ha merecido el reconocimiento general, su diversificación formal y su contenido fragmentario reclamaban, ya en el siglo xxi, su codificación. El Código Civil de Cataluña es hoy una realidad vigente en cinco de sus seis libros proyectados, a la espera de ser completada, en un futuro próximo, con el Libro sexto, relativo a las obligaciones y los contratos.

Taking as a starting point an interpretation of the television medium as an Ideological State Apparatus, this book examines how gender roles and non-heteronormative sexualities are constructed in Spanish and Catalan television series. In the first part, which focuses on the construction of gender roles in Catalan soap operas, it applies the analytical paradigms founded by Anglo-Saxon feminist scholars for the content of soap operas to a corpus of material which has rarely been analysed through this perspective. In the second part, which focuses on the construction of non-heteronormative sexualities in Spanish and Catalan television series, the book challenges the rhetoric of "normalisation" and the "essentialist" paradigms which have so far dominated the examination of the construction of sexuality in television series. As such, this book addresses the role performed by television in the construction of meanings which surround gender issues and non-heteronormative sexualities. This is a timely exercise because gender studies and studies of sexual dissidence are fairly recent fields in Spanish and Catalan academia and television has been largely disregarded, especially as far as the analysis of characters and storylines is concerned. As a result, this book represents a major contribution to these fields in the Spanish and Catalan contexts. Guardonat amb el Premi d'Assaig «Càtedra Blasco», el punt de partida d'aquest llibre és una reflexió sobre la relació entre l'escriptura (el relat, l'assaig autobiogràfic) i el seu entorn físic.
